Notes on main cities: Dublin, Cork, Limerick, Galway, Waterford

- The proportion of primary school children walking and cycling fell in every city
- The proportion of secondary school children walking and cycling fell in every city except Galway
- The proportion of 3rd level students walking and cycling increased in Dublin, Cork and Limerick and fell in Galway and Waterford. (Cycling participation also fell in Galway and Waterford)
- The proportion of workers walking and cycling fell in every city except Dublin (Cycling participation grew in Dublin, Cork, Galway and fell in Limerick and Waterford).
