A photo each time you practice your school route - ie. something along your route, getting ready etc. (Max 20 points /10 trips)

Photo of a dangerous junction or road crossing

A place on your route that you would like to see better infrastructure for school cycles (write what you would like to see on the facebook post)

A short film (3 min max) of members of your group talking about what you thought of the competition, the route or improvements you would like to see.
